

Bangle Bag

Materials

DK yarn or thread, 2 x 3inch plastic bangles,
4.00mm hook

Notes

I inserted beads to make a pattern as I went along. If you do this, thread the beads on next. Alternatively, you could cross stitch a design on afterwards.

Directions

1st Side

Row 1: Slst yarn to bangle, 20sc on to bangle, turn. (20sts)

Row 2: 1ch, sc in each sc, turn.

Row 3: 1ch, sc in next 5sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 2sc) 4 times, sc in next 3sc, turn. (24sts)

Row 4: As Row 2.

Row 5: 1ch, sc in next 7sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 2sc) 4 times, sc in next 5sc, turn. (28sts)

Row 6: As Row 2.

Row 7: 1ch, sc in next 7sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 3sc) 4 times, sc in next 5sc, turn. (32sts)

Row 8: As Row 2.

Row 9: 1ch, sc in next 4sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 6sc) 4 times, turn. (36sts)

Row 10: As Row 2.

Row 11: 1ch, sc in next 12sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 11sc) twice, turn. (38sts)



Row 12: As Row 2.

Row 13: 1ch, sc in next 13sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 11sc) twice, sc in next sc, turn. (40sts)

Rows 14 & 15: As Row 2.
Fasten off.

2nd Side

Follow directions for 1st side. Do not fasten off, continue as follows.

Row 16: 1ch, sc in each sc across this side then across 1st side, slst to 1st ch, turn. (80sts)

Continue working on these 80 sts until bag is the size you want it. Fold in half and working through both sides together, sc in each sc, fasten off and sew in ends. (40 sts)
