

## Bow



### General Notes

**Turning ch:** the chain at beginning of rows is for turning only and not counted as a stitch unless otherwise stated.

**Joining Slip Stitch:** This slip stitch is for joining only and not counted as a stitch.

**Starting chain:** Always work into the back loop of the starting chain. This gives a neater finish, making both the bottom and top of the work look the same. When working into unused loops, pick up both loops as you would when working into the tops of other stitches.

**Right side:** This is the outside or the front of the work.

**Wrong side:** This is the inside or the back of the work.

### Instructions

**Row 1:** 1ch, ss in ch, 78ch, ss in 1<sup>st</sup> ch, dc in next 76ch, ss in next ch, turn. (79sts)

**Row 2:** Miss ss, ss in next dc, dc in next 11dc, ss in next dc, turn. (13sts)

**Row 3:** Miss ss, dc in next 9dc, ss in next dc, turn. (10sts)

**Row 4:** Miss ss, ss in next dc, dc in next 6dc, ss in next dc, turn. (8sts)

**Row 5:** Miss ss, dc in next 6dc, 2dc in next ss, 2ch, turn. (10sts)

**Row 6:** Ss in 1<sup>st</sup> ch, dc in next ch, dc in next 8dc, dc in same dc as ss, dc in next dc, dc in same dc as ss, 2dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2dc in next dc, dc in next 17dc, ss in next dc, turn. (34sts)

**Row 7:** Miss ss, dc in next 13dc, ss in next dc, turn. (14sts)

**Row 8:** Miss ss, dc in next 11dc, ss in next dc, turn. (12sts)

**Row 9:** Miss ss, dc in next 11dc, dc in same dc as ss, dc in next dc, ss in next dc, turn. (14sts)

**Row 10:** Miss ss, dc in next 13dc, dc in same dc as ss, dc in next dc, dc in same dc as ss, (dc in next dc, dc2tog) twice, dc in next 16dc, ss in next dc, turn. (37sts)

**Rows 11-13:** As rows 7-9.

**Row 14:** Miss ss, dc in next 13dc, dc in same dc as ss, dc in next dc, dc in same dc as ss, 2dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 9ch, dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, dc in next 2ch, htr in next ch, tr in next 3ch, dc in next ch, 2dc in next dc, dc in next 14dc, ss in next dc, turn.

**Row 15:** Miss ss, ss in next dc, dc in next 10dc, ss in next dc, turn. (12sts)

**Row 16:** Miss ss, dc in next 8dc, ss in next dc, 3ch, turn. (12sts)

**Row 17:** Ss in 1<sup>st</sup> ch, dc in next 2ch, dc in next 7dc, ss in next dc, turn. (11sts)

**Row 18:** Miss ss, dc in next 9dc, dc in next ss, 1ch, turn. (11sts)

**Row 19:** Ss in 1<sup>st</sup> ch, dc in next 10dc, dc in same dc as ss, dc in next dc, dc in same dc as ss, dc in next 5dc, miss next dc, dc in next 7sts, 3dc in next dc, working along other side of ch in unused loops, miss 1<sup>st</sup> ch, 2dc in next ch, dc in next 7 ch, miss

next dc, dc in next 18dc, dc in same dc as ss, dc in next 20dc, dc in same dc as ss, dc in next 18dc, dc in next ss, 1ch, ss in ch, ss to end of row 6, fasten off and sew in ends.



Place bow right side down on table with row 1 closest to you.

Fold right hand side over.



Fold left hand side over.

Holding pieces in place, turn complete bow over.

Fold tab down and tuck under.



Sew in place.
