

## Materials:

**Thread Rainbows** - DMC Perle or Petra Size 5 in red, orange, yellow, green mid blue, royal blue and violet, 2.00mm hook, needle for sewing in ends.

**Yarn Rainbows** - DK yarn in red, orange, yellow, green mid blue, royal blue and violet, 4.00mm hook, needle for sewing in ends.



## General Notes

**Turning ch:** the chain at beginning of rows is for turning only and not counted as a stitch unless other wise stated.

**Starting chain:** Always work into the back loop of the starting chain. This gives a neater finish, making both the bottom and top of the work look the same.

## Small Rainbow

**Row 1:** 8ch in purple, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sc in next ch, 2sc in next ch, sc in next ch, 2sc in next ch, sc in next 2ch, change to royal, turn. (9sts)

**Row 2:** 1ch, sc in next 2sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 3sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 2sc, change to blue, turn. (11sts)

**Row 3:** 1ch, sc in next 2sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next sc) 3 times, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 2sc, change to green, turn. (15sts)

**Row 4:** 1ch, (sc in next 2sc, 2sc in next sc) twice, sc in next 3sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 2sc) twice, change to yellow, turn. (19sts)

**Row 5:** 1ch, sc in next 3sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 3sc) 4 times, change to orange, turn. (23sts)

**Row 6:** 1ch, sc in next sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 3sc) 5 times, 2sc in next sc, sc in next sc, change to red, turn. (29sts)

**Row 7:** 1ch, sc in next 14sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 14sc, fasten off and sew in ends.

# Large Rainbow

- Row 1:** 12ch in purple, 2sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, (sc in next ch, 2sc in next ch) 5 times, turn. (17sts)
- Row 2:** 1ch, sc in next 2sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 3sc) 3 times, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 2sc, change to royal, turn. (21sts)
- Row 3:** 1ch, sc in each sc, turn.
- Row 4:** 1ch, sc in next 4sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 3sc) 3 times, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 4sc, change to blue, turn. (25 sts)
- Row 5:** 1ch, sc in each sc, turn.
- Row 6:** 1ch, sc in next 2sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 3sc) 5 times, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 2sc, change to green, turn. (31sts)
- Row 7:** 1ch, sc in each sc, turn.
- Row 8:** 1ch, sc in next 4sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 4sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 3sc) 3 times, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 4sc) twice, change to yellow, turn. (37sts)
- Row 9:** 1ch, sc in each sc, turn.
- Row 10:** 1ch, sc in next 4sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 4sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 5sc) 3 times, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 4sc) twice, change to orange, turn. (43sts)
- Row 11:** 1ch, sc in each sc, turn.
- Row 12:** 1ch, (sc in next 4sc, 2sc in next sc) 4 times, sc in next 3sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 4sc) 4 times, change to red, turn. (51sts)
- Row 13:** 1ch, sc in each sc, turn.
- Row 14:** 1ch, sc in next 4sc, (2sc in next sc, sc in next 5sc) 7 times, 2sc in next sc, sc in next 4sc, fasten off and sew in ends.
