

Santa Hat

A quick and easy pattern to make a Santa hat to hang on the Christmas tree. You can make it in yarn or thread for different sizes.

Materials

DK yarn in red and white, polyester filling, 4.00mm hook. This makes one about 10cm (4ins) tall.

Top

Rnd 1: 2ch in white, 6dc in 1st ch, mark as right side, ss to 2nd ch, turn. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 1ch, 2dc in each dc, ss to 1st ch, turn. (12sts)

Rnd 3: 1ch, dc in each dc, ss to 1st ch, turn.

Rnd 4: 1ch, dc2tog 6 times, ss to 1st ch, turn. (6sts)

Rnd 5: 1ch, dc2tog 3 times, change to red, ss to 1st ch, turn. (3sts)

Rnd 6: 1ch, 2dc in each dc, ss to 1st ch, turn. (6sts)

Rnd 7: 10ch, ss to 1st ch, (forms hanging loop), 1ch, dc in each dc, making sure loop is to right side, ss to 1st ch, turn.

Rnd 8: 1ch, (2dc in next dc, dc in next dc) 3times, ss to 1st ch, turn. (9sts)

Rnd 9: 1ch, dc in each dc, ss to 1st ch, turn.

Rnd 10: 1ch, (2dc in next dc, dc in next 2dc) 3 times, ss to 1st ch, turn. (12sts)

Rnd 11: 1ch, dc in each dc, ss to 1st ch, turn.

Rnd 12: 1ch, (2dc in next dc, dc in next 3dc) 3 times, ss to 1st ch, turn. (15sts)

Rnd 13: 1ch, dc in each dc, ss to 1st ch, turn.

Rnd 14: 1ch, (2dc in next dc, dc in next 4dc) 3 times, ss to 1st ch, turn. (18sts)

Rnd 15: 1ch, dc in each dc, ss to 1st ch, turn.

Rnd 16: 1ch, (2dc in next dc, dc in next 5dc) 3



times, ss to 1st ch, turn. (21sts)

Rnd 17: 1ch, dc in each dc, ss to 1st ch, turn.

Rnd 18: 1ch, (2dc in next dc, dc in next 8dc) 3 times, ss to 1st ch, turn. (24sts)

Rnd 19: 1ch, dc in each dc, ss to 1st ch, fasten off and sew in ends.

Base

Rnd 1: 2ch in white, 6dc in 1st ch, mark as right side, ss to 2nd ch, turn. (6sts)

Rnd 2: 1ch, 2dc in each dc, ss to 1st ch, turn. (12sts)

Rnd 3: 1ch, (2dc in next dc, dc in next dc) 6 times, ss to 1st ch, turn. (18sts)

Rnd 4: 1ch, (2dc in next dc, dc in next 2dc) 6 times, ss to 1st ch, turn. (24sts)

Place top and base together with wrong sides facing, matching up dc's and work through both layers. With hat top pointing towards you, continue as follows.

Lightly stuff when you have done about 2/3 of rnd 5.

Rnd 5: 3ch, 4tr in each dc, ss to 3rd ch, fasten off and sew in ends.
